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Course Description: Biology is the study of life. It is a rapidly changing field that encompasses a wide range of topics from structure of life to the interaction of living organisms between themselves and their environment. Special emphasis is placed on the scientific method as a way to answer a wide variety of questions about life and the universe. Emphasis is also placed on the characteristics that **ALL** living organisms share, which include the following: a genetic blue print, a cellular make up, growth and development, the ability to reproduce, reaction and response, energy use, evolution, and homeostasis. Students will not only gain a basic body of knowledge that explores our current understanding of biological themes, but will also investigate current events, issues, and technology.

Course Goals: My goal is to provide instruction that will aide in your understanding of biology, enhance your in interest in biological processes, and able you to complete this course successfully. We will use a variety of methods to reach these goals including lab-based activities, individual and group work, and projects.

Grading Policy: Grades are weighted as follows: labs and projects = 30% classwork and homework = 20%, exams, quizzes = 35%, finals = 10%, and participation = 5%. Participation points are given for regular and on time attendance and full participation in all class activities. Below are the percentages and corresponding grades that will be used in this class:
